After deep research into the flipped learning pedagogy and a willingness to completely innovate, the school entered into a partnership with Atomi in 2015.



## Strategy

Atomi videos allow learning at St Mark's to be personalised, supportive and to break beyond the boundaries of the 9 am to 3 pm school day. With constant support for teachers and students, Atomi was integrated to complement the initiatives already working in the school such as Google Classroom and Bring Your Own Device (BYOD).

Using the Google Classroom app to construct lessons, Atomi videos function as the core element of content delivery around which teachers have added other resources, lesson planning and worksheets to promote learning.

## Impact

At St Mark's Catholic College, the flipped learning pedagogy is working to full effect. The majority of departments are allocating Atomi lessons to students each week as the 'pre-work' in their wider learning experience and using class time to focus on developing understanding under the direction of skilled teachers.
